Habib's background as a federal prosecutor makes him particularly valuable to clients in civil cases that involve a parallel criminal investigation. Habib also conducts internal investigations and counsels individual and corporate clients on a variety of federal and state compliance issues in the healthcare, technology, aviation, and the food and beverage sectors.

A Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers, Habib frequently manages mass tort litigation involving dockets of several thousand cases across multiple jurisdictions.
